


KANSAS YMCAs ARE CARING FOR COMMUNITY

When the doors to our facilities closed in March 2020, YMCAs across the state kept on serving and caring for community. Kansas Ys have cared for children, families, seniors and neighbors during the pandemic.

Provided **YMCA 360**, virtual exercise classes used by **over 2.5 million users** throughout the entire country.

Partnered with the state and local school districts to provide over **3,550 elementary and middle school students** with remote learning support at **76 sites**, allowing parents to continue working while ensuring their kids are safe and not falling behind in their schoolwork.

Checked in on over **12,500 seniors**, **hosted** blood drives and **delivered** meals and masks to folks at home.



Served more than **250,000 meals** to children and families across the state to help combat food insecurity.

Partnered with **local organizations** throughout the state to distribute food, offer remote learning support, provide vital community services and address vaccine equity.

Nurtured an average of **335 children** every day at emergency childcare sites.

Kansans joined together to **write hundreds of letters to lawmakers** advocating for relief for nonprofits.

"Thank you God, for this program. The staff is so unbelievable! They are SO good with the kids. They are so uplifting!"


